ST ATHANASIUS St Athanasius was a five-times exiled Bishop of Alexandria. He opposed the heresy of "Arianism" and strongly defended the Council of Nicaea. Famous for his theological writings, Athanasius clarified the notion of the Trinity. He underlined the full divinity of the Holy Spirit, equal to that of the Son. He died c.373 and his feast day is on 2nd May.


